

Special Council meeting

Subject to confirmation, it is Council's intention to hold a Special Council meeting on:

- Council resolving its position on the planning permit application for a tourist resort at 275 Barham River Road, Apollo Bay, which will be communicated to the Planning Panel established by the Minister for Planning.

Council's position is required to be presented to the Planning Panel scheduled to convene on 16 April 2018. In the event the Planning Panel decide to defer the commencement of the Hearing, the Special Council meeting will be cancelled and Council will consider its position at a future meeting.

Those who have previously made submissions to the planning permit will be invited to present to Council at the Special Council meeting.
