State Government Sports Funding now open

2019-20 Community Sports Infrastructure Fund.

The Community Sports Infrastructure Fund (CSIF) is now open for applications. To apply for funding, sporting organisations and clubs must work closely with Colac Otway Shire Council to develop project ready applications.

The program provides grants that support the provision for more modern and accessible community sport and recreation facilities and infrastructure in Victoria that can be enjoyed by everyone regardless of age, background, gender or ability. Working together we can make sport more inclusive, increase local participation and accessibility of the sport, whilst providing opportunities to stimulate the local



Community sport and recreation organisations can nominate possible projects under the Minor Facilities category to develop or upgrade local sport and recreation facilities where communities conduct, organise and participate in sport and recreation in the Colac Otway Shire. Council can apply for grants of up to \$250,000 on a Sport and Recreation Victoria (SRV) \$2:\$1 local matching contribution basis.

2018-19 Female Friendly Facilities Fund.

The Female Friendly Facilities Fund supports the growing demand for more modern and accessible community sports infrastructure to make a difference for women and girls participation. Examples of projects could be introducing lighting to make training safer, improving grounds or upgrading change rooms for women and girls.

To apply for funding, sporting organisations and clubs must work closely with Colac Otway Shire Council to develop project ready applications. Council can apply for grants for one or more venues with a total combined funding request of up to \$500,000 on a SRV \$2:\$1 local matching contribution basis.
