Waste transfer stations going cashless

Council wishes to advise from July 1, transfer stations at Apollo Bay, Alvie and Birregurra will no longer accept cash payments. To dispose of waste and recycling material, payment will need to be made by EFTPOS or Tip Tickets.

Tip Tickets are available for purchase from Customer Service Centres in Apollo Bay and Colac in books of 10 for \$70.00 or 25 tickets for \$150.00 - they are the cheapest way to dispose of general waste at transfer stations within the shire and have no expiry date, so keep them in a safe place.
