Construction of road slips stabilisation works (retaining walls, drainage & erosion) - Barham River Road, Apollo Bay

Contract No. 1904

The existing Barham River Road alignment at the location of the project consists of an embankment built over a water course that, due to the September 2016 flood event, has failed forming a slip adjacent to the road alignment.

Tenders are invited from experienced contractors to provide an earth retaining structure to support fill material and new road pavement to enable a safer transit of public traffic through this section of the road.
