Notice of Exhibition of Draft Colac Otway Tourism Parking and Traffic Strategy and draft Kennett River Tourism Parking and Traffic Strategy

Exhibition Period from Monday 7 January to Friday 15 March 2019

Colac Otway Shire Council has prepared the draft *Colac Otway Tourism Parking and Traffic Strategy* for Apollo Bay, Skenes Creek, Marengo, Wye River, Separation Creek, Lavers Hill, Forrest, and Kennett River. A draft of the Kennett River Tourism Parking and Traffic Strategy has also been prepared as a standalone document for Kennett River. **The draft strategies are now on public exhibition**.

The strategies seek to outline the traffic and parking infrastructure requirements for the towns along the Great Ocean Road to cater for the growing number of tourists and challenges they present, whilst respecting valued characteristics of each town.

The strategies do not deal with the sections of the arterial road network between the towns which are the responsibility of State Government.

You may inspect the *draft Colac Otway Tourism Parking and Traffic Strategy or Kennett River Tourism Parking and Traffic Strategy* free of charge, at the following locations during office hours:

Any person who may be affected by the draft Strategy may make a submission to Council about the Strategy. Submissions must be made in writing giving the submitter's name and contact address, clearly stating the grounds on which the draft Strategy is supported or opposed and indicating what changes

(if any) the submitter wishes to make.

To assist Council in their response to submissions, it is useful to explain what parts of the Strategy the submission relates to, and explain any suggested changes and reasons for these changes.

Name and contact details of submitters are required for Council to consider submissions and to notify such persons of the opportunity to attend Council meetings. The closing date for submissions is **Friday 15 March 2019**. Apex Pre School Centre Inc. Lease

Colac Otway Shire Council gives notice of its intention to enter into a Lease with Apex Pre School Centre Inc. under Section 190 of the *Local Government Act 1989* (*the 'Act'*). The property is located at 7 Howarth Street, Elliminyt.

The proposed lease is prepared under the *Crown Land* (*Reserves*) *Act 1978* with the following terms:

Rent: \$150 per annum (incl GST).

Lease term: 15 years.

Rent review: Compound C.P.I % at the fifth yearly anniversary of commencement of the Lease and every fifth year thereafter.

Outgoings: The lessee is responsible for all outgoings and maintenance.

Permitted use: Pre School Facility.

Any person may make a submission relating to the proposal in writing to the Chief Executive, PO Box 283, Colac, Victoria 3250.

All submissions will be considered in accordance with section 223 of the Act and must be submitted in writing by 1 March 2018. People requesting to be heard in support of their submission are entitled to do so (or be represented) and will be notified of the time and date of the hearing.
