Road closure - intersection upgrade works Sheehan's Road and Kenny's Lane, Cororooke

Colac Otway Shire Council wishes to advise of the following road closures which will be in place while intersection upgrades works are undertaken:

Location: Sheehan's Road and Kenny's Lane, Cororooke

When: Works will commence from Monday 29 April 2019 and are expected to be completed by the end of May (subject to weather conditions).

Works: The intersection of Sheehan's Road and Kenny's Lane, Cororooke will be closed for the duration of these works. Detours will be setup for public traffic, while local residents will be able to use these roads to access properties that adjoin the closed intersection. Traffic management will be in place to minimise disruption to the community. Emergency access will be maintained at all times.

Road users, pedestrians and cyclists are asked to take care and observe any road signs in place. Council apologises for any inconvenience and thanks people for their patience while these important works are undertaken.
