Flying Fox Management plan community consultation

The Colac Botanic Gardens has experienced ongoing visitation by grey-headed flying foxes which are considered as a vulnerable and threatened species. Council is concerned about the health of the historic trees where the mammals are roosting and is also concerned about the amenity of the botanic gardens for visitors and surrounding area.

Council will be undertaking a Flying Fox Management Plan to ensure that best practice requirements are met and to respond to community concerns.
