In-Harbour Dredging Project

A major in-harbour dredging project is scheduled to commence at the Port of Apollo Bay from Monday 20 April 2020. This project is expected to take 6-8 weeks to complete and will remove 55,000m³ of sand from inside the harbour, resulting in the dredge area returning to a depth of -3.5m ensuring safe navigation inside the harbour and increasing usability of the port.
