



Ordinary Council meeting

The June 2020 Council meeting will be held on:

Wednesday 24 June, 4pm at COPACC, Gellibrand Street, Colac.

The Ordinary Council meeting will be livestreamed to the public (where the technology is available) via Council's YouTube channel (search Colac Otway Shire Council at www.youtube.com).

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic and in accordance with the Stay Safe and Restricted Activities Directions issued by the Chief Health Officer of Victoria that are in place at the time of publication, Council advises only Councillors and Council staff are permitted to attend the Ordinary Council meeting. Strict hygiene and social distancing measures will be in place.

The current State of Emergency remains until 11.59pm 21 June 2020. If an easing of relevant restrictions occurs at that time and Council is able to physically open the Ordinary Council meeting to the public, further details will be advised via Council's communication channels.

Council Customer Service Centres reopened

Council reopened its Customer Service Centres in Colac and Apollo Bay on Tuesday 9 June. A number of measures are in place to ensure safety and compliance with Victorian Government COVID restrictions:

- Cashless payments are preferred
- There is a limit to the number of customers in the Customer Service Centre (maximum of one person per four square metres) at a time
- A physical distance of 1.5 metres between people must be maintained at all times
- Hand sanitising stations are in place for customer use

While Customer Service Centres have opened, Council encourages the Colac Otway community to utilise online information and payment services via the Council website to limit the number of trips away from home.
