Additional Green Waste Disposal Services

Colac Otway Shire Council is supporting residents in the clean-up of recent storm events with free green waste disposal at Transfer Stations and Drop-Off Facilities.

A 6 x 4 trailer of non-commercial green waste can be taken to Alvie and Apollo Bay waste drop off centres during business hours.

Free disposal of green waste from the storm clean up can be taken to the Beech Forest, Lavers Hill, Carlisle River and Gellibrand Drop-Off Facilities. Council will also have the green waste skips in Wye River and Kennett River from this week.
