

Snapshot of Council's August meeting

- Colac Otway Shire Council's Asset Management Policy and Domestic Wastewater Management Plan (DWMP) were both adopted at the August meeting.
- Council's first Public Toilet Strategy was adopted, providing a framework for decision-making regarding the provision, management and maintenance of public toilet facilities in Colac Otway Shire over the next ten years and includes recommendations for asset rationalisation.
- Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) Advocacy for Action was put forward as a Notice of Motion by Councillor Chris Potter. Council resolved to write to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry to advocate for continuing increased measures to prevent an outbreak of FMD and raise awareness of FMD.

Council's Colac City Reserves have draft master plans open for public consultation until 11 September.

The master plans map out a vision for the future development of these reserves and this will support future funding applications to the state and federal governments.

Eastern Reserve is shared by cricket, baseball and netball players and families, and Western Reserve caters for women's and men's football, netball and cricket players and families. Plans for both reserves propose upgrades to change rooms to meet current sports facility standards for all gender sports participation.

Improvements to walking paths, parking and traffic movements are also included in the master plans. Other key priorities include upgrades to playing surfaces and new practice facilities.
