## **Draft Resource Recovery and Waste** Management Strategy

The Colac Otway Shire Draft Resource Recovery and Waste Management Strategy outlines sustainable resource recovery and waste management strategies for the shire for the next ten years.

The purpose of the Draft Strategy is to set a vision for the community to manage waste and resource recovery in a way that minimises impacts on the environment.

The draft Strategy provides actions and plans which will deliver better waste and resource recovery services, that support the community in continuing to minimise waste generation and maximise waste diversion from landfill.

# **Rates Payments**

If you have elected to pay your rates by quarterly instalment, please note the fourth instalment payment due date is Monday 31 May 2021.

Council also reminds ratepayers, lump sum rates payments for 2020-21 were due on 15 February 2021.

During COVID-19, Colac Otway Shire Council introduced an interest free period on overdue rates - but this finishes on June 30 this year.

Your overdue rates must be paid by June 30 to avoid interest charges.

Rates can be paid online or via Bpay. No interest will be charged on late payments if you are unable to pay in person due to office closures.
