Colac Otway Shire covers an area of 3,438 square kilometres and Council is responsible for managing and maintaining over 1,600 kilometres of sealed and unsealed roads through the Shire. All roads that Council is responsible for are listed on our website under the Public Road Register. COPACC Civic Hall Floor Renewal

Works involve renewal of Colac Otway Performing Arts and Cultural Centre (COPACC) Civic Hall through strengthening the floor to increase the maximum loading capacity. This includes removing the timber floor boards enabling the structural reinforcement of the stumps, bearers and pier connections.
