

Immunisation

Council's free immunisation sessions are held in Colac on the first Thursday and the third Monday of the month at COPACC and by appointment every Monday in Apollo Bay at the Apollo Bay Kindergarten building located at the P-12 College site on Pengilley Avenue. Upcoming immunisations sessions in Colac are:

Council also has flu vaccine available for infants under five years of age and adults aged 65 and over. The flu vaccine for these age groups will be available at all Council immunisation sessions.

Lake Colac Holiday Park - Contract Management Agreement

At the July meeting, Council resolved to give a two-month extension to the agreement for BelgraviaPRO to continue to manage operations of the Lake Colac Holiday Park. Council released an Expression of Interest (EOI) for the lease of the Lake Colac Holiday Park which closed to submissions on 5 May 2023. The post-submission EOI process is still occurring and a report will be presented to a future Council meeting to consider the outcome of the Lake Colac Holiday Park Lease EOI process.

Declaration of Road Reserve in Ricstan Court, Elliminyt

Council will publish a notice in the Government Gazette to declare a Reserve at the end of Ricstan Court in Elliminyt to be a road. The opening up of Ricstan Court was part of a development plan for the area which was developed by Council in 2014. Development of the area will open up land for much-needed residential housing lots in Colac.

Contract 2122 Breakwater Remediation Project - Sheet Pile Wall

Council awarded a revised contract for the Port of Apollo Bay Breakwall Remediation. following an increase in costs since the time the contract was awarded in October 2022. The project is to undertake a series of essential remediation works to maintain key Port Infrastructure, namely to the Lee Breakwater wall structure in the Port. In May 2021, Council was successful in obtaining a \$3.512 million grant from the Department of Transport to complete the works.
