



Colac Aerodrome Works

### Council advise contractor Grout Electrical Pty Ltd has been engaged to carry out works to renew/upgrade the Colac Aerodrome runway lighting system.

To ensure safety of the contractors, aerodrome users and the public, a closure of both the sealed and grass aerodrome runways is required and no aircraft (plane or helicopter) usage is permitted while contractors are on site carrying out ground works, however access to hangars will not be restricted. Electrical work will be carried out following the ground works.

The upgrade works are expected to be completed by 6 September 2024.

- Aerodrome closure - ground works installation of new runway lighting infrastructure - both runways will close from 15 July to 16 August 2024.
