2024 Election Period

The 2024 Election Period (commonly known as caretaker period), will commence at noon on Tuesday 17 September 2024 and concludes at 6pm on Saturday 26 October 2024.

The Election Period starts from the last day that nominations to be a candidate for a council election can be received and ends at 6pm on election day.

During this period, council business is conducted in accordance with our Election Period Policy which can be read on our website as part of Council's Governance Rules.
